FRONT FOYER

This is the first impression of your home, so make it a grand one! In the apartment's front entrance area, we opted for full-on "glamour." Walls were finished in faux eel skin wallpaper. Underfoot, soft white and grey vein cut marble tile. Brass-detailed furniture, hides and elegant glass sconces add rich, textural layers into the space.

BATHROOMS

Regardless if your home is large or small, if the space is shared with one or eight, one thing is certain - the need for enough bathrooms. This home design tackled demand right from the get-go. The new floor plan included ensuite baths in all


